Team outline and delivery partnership

The Community Asset Navigator Programme is being delivered through a partnership led by Bolton CVS and key voluntary and community sector organisations; working collaboratively with partners from Bolton Council, NHS Bolton Clinical Commissioning Group, Bolton GP Federation, Healthwatch Bolton and NHS Bolton Foundation Trust.

Bolton CVS will host **3.2** full time equivalent (FTE) posts, including;

- 0.2 FTE Programme Manager to manage cross sector relationships and to oversee the project plan and performance.
- 1 FTE Community Asset Navigator Co-ordinator who will have day-to-day line management, coaching and team development responsibility.
- 1 FTE Community Investments Programme Officer who will oversee the distribution of the Health and Wellbeing Community Investments, supporting and connecting voluntary and community sector groups to the broader capacity building offer.
- 1 FTE Community Asset Information Worker, with responsibility for providing up-to-date information on voluntary and community sector groups and organisations, supporting the sharing of information and ensuring that data collection and outcomes monitoring across the programme.

Voluntary and Community Sector Partners will host 5 FTE Community Asset Navigators, seconded to Bolton CVS:

- 1 FTE Community Asset Navigator; Emotional Wellbeing – BAND.
- 1 FTE Community Asset Navigator; Physical Activity – Bolton Wanderers Community Trust.
- 1 FTE Community Asset Navigator; Social Inclusion – Octagon Theatre.
- 1 FTE Community Asset Navigator; Young People – Bolton Lads and Girls Club.
- 1 FTE Community Asset Navigator; Ageing – Age UK Bolton.
