Group	Amount	Project
Flowhesion Foundation	£5,000	To deliver a bilingual line to provide clarity on covid19 guidelines and restriction in Bolton to non-proficient Pakistani community.
Backup North West	£817.25	To support 16-25 year old homeless young people to participate in safe practice for COVID-19.
Youth Leads	£3,000	Youth Leads UK will educate and inform young Boltonians aged 11-30 on the impact of COVID-19.
Ephrata Church Community	£1,000	Increase awareness about testing and tracing for COVID-19, changing behaviour about mask wearing among Black African community in Bolton.
Breakdown Bolton	£3,743	To provide mask making kits, shop window display, quilt, photo exhibition, workshops, health information sharing around key COVID-19 related messages.
Harmony Youth Project	£2,525	To produce a "Rap" music video by young people uplifting and inspiring on Covid-19.
The Sunnyside Club	£1,275	To provide support and engagement for young people guidance around Covid-19 such as Risks, Prevention and Safety
Zacs Bar / the Sycamore project	£4,940	To deliver workshops for young people on the impact of COVID-19 and how to stay safe and managing risks during the pandemic.
Bolton Solidarity Community Association	£4,460	To develop on from previous work to use community champions, BAMER nurses who are working on the front line and community members with lived experience of COVID-19.
The Great Lever Voice	£1,370	To engage with young people and to train volunteers on risk management of COVID-19.
Blackrod Sports and Community Centre	£1,500	To work user groups to promote positive messages around COVID prevention and using PPE in all settings.
