Fund Priorities

- 1. Provide free holiday places for children and young people, aged 4-16, and / or including provision for children with SEND or additional needs.
- 2. We will prioritise projects that are actively targeting children and young people who are eligible for free school meals (a minimum of 85% of attendees to your provision must be in the target group) but where possible the project will be open to all children and young people who wish to attend.
- 3. Activities should be for at least 4 hours a day on 4 days a week over the 2023 Easter School Holiday Period.
- 4. HAF funded activities should include the following activities in each session in order to be eligible for the funding: Enriching Activities, Food, Physical Activities, Food education for children, families and carers.
