## Case Studies Bolton's Fund: Winter HAF 2023

## Oldham Greenhill Community Sports and Recreation Club (OGCSRC)

OGCSRC were awarded £3,182 to deliver a 4 day HAF programme at Pikes Lane Community Centre, Bolton, BL3 5EL over the school Christmas hoidays.

- They offered multi-sports and recreational activities throughout the four days. The activities included football, cricket, dodgeball and handball. Sports Coaches will be delivering these activities. They also provided arts & craft activities alongside board games for children to be engaged and work with the peers and make new friends.
- OGCSRC is a registered charity whose mission is to support the local communities. They plan
  and organise activities for the local communities of Greater Manchester including sports and
  recreational activities, children soft play areas, educational, cooking, sewing classes, mental
  health and wellbeing classes. They create volunteering opportunities within our organisation,
  providing food parcels for deprived and vulnerable families, youth club and access to adult
  vocational and non-vocational courses. They also empower children, young people and adults
  to become active through fitness, reducing isolation and improving mental wellbeing.
- They aimed to have 40 children particapte each day.





Be the Change Youth Project CIC were awarded £2,140 for their BTC Holiday Club HAF project. Their activities will run from their centre in Rumworth.

- Be The Change is an award winning youth organisation based in Bolton. They
  work with young people from disadvantaged backgrounds to provide
  opportunities for growth and improvement, giving them the foundations to
  succeed.
- They will use this grant to fund the costs associated with running sporting, arts, music and cooking sessions.
- They aimed to support 25 young people each day at their activity sessions.
